This Photo Safari is a Leave No Trace scavenger hunt in Hyalite Canyon. Your task - take a photo of at least one item in each category on the Photo Safari list. The theme of this photo safari is "leave what you find". By taking photos of the neat things you find in Hyalite you'll be able to remember and share your experiences and leave them behind for others to find and enjoy too!

For each item, take a photo and record details such as the location and species, type of rock, or name of waterbody on the checklist. Once you've completed the checklist, send it, with your photos, to Friends of Hyalite by emailing it to info@hyalite.org with the subject line "Photo Safari your name". We also encourage you to post your photos on the HyaliteFest Facebook group page.

It may be necessary to send us multiple emails if your photo attachments exceed 25MB. If that's the case, just add "2", "3", etc. to the subject line (ex: "Photo Safari Smokey Bear 2"). **Completed checklists must be submitted by 8pm on August 21.**

All photos submitted will become the property of Friends of Hyalite and may be used on the Friends of Hyalite website or other Friends of Hyalite materials.

Participants who submit completed entries by 8pm on August 21 will be entered into the prize drawing and prize winners will be announced on the HyaliteFest Facebook group page (and notified via email) on August 23.
